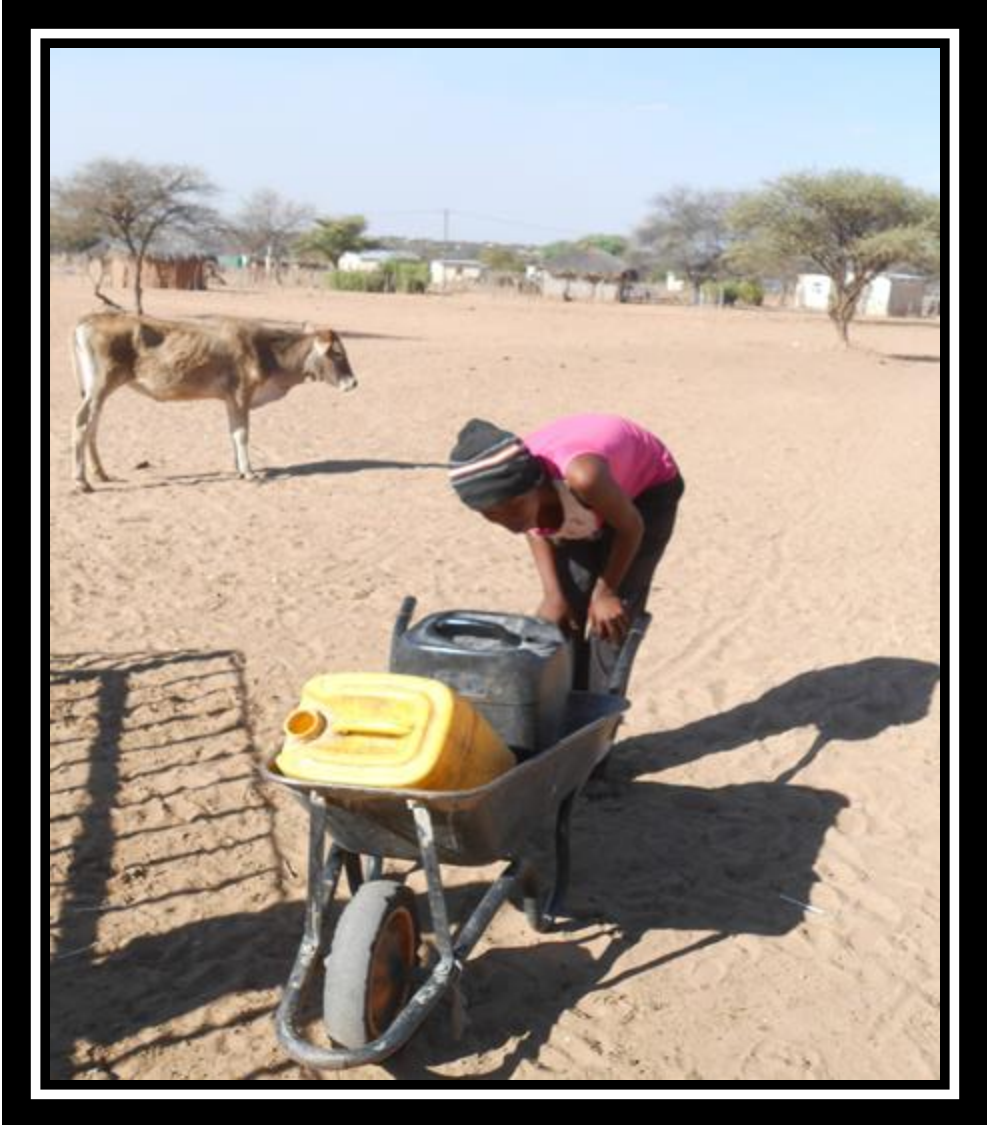

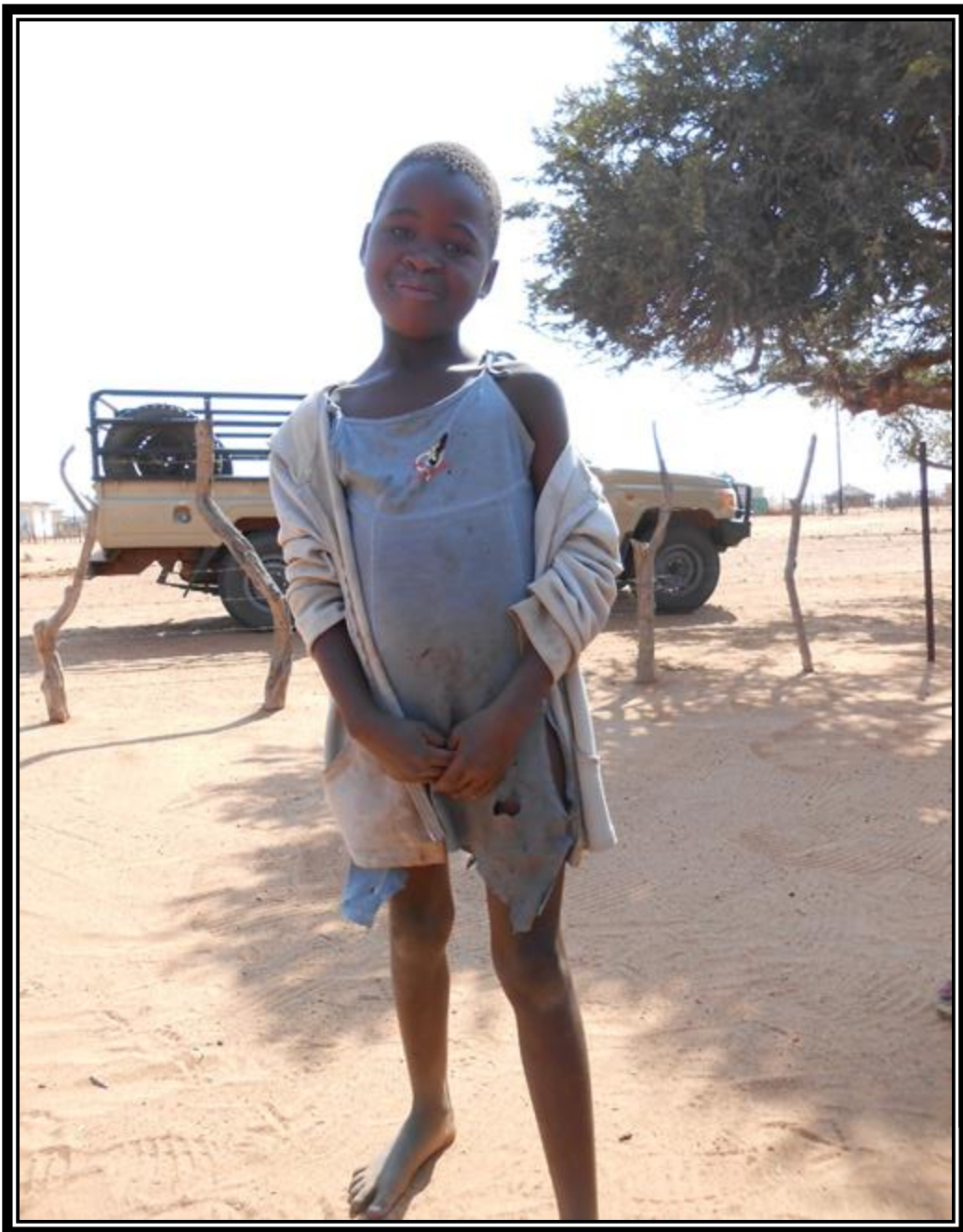

CHALLENGES IN THE WORK

- 1) In times of drought brethren struggle to grow their crops and really suffer when there is no rain , with definite signs of weather pattern change, these drought conditions become repetitive and more frequent.
- 2)The distance I travel each month is an average of 4000 -5000 miles per month on bad roads , my pick-up takes a hammering and does not last longer than 3 years without becoming unreliable .New vehicles are very expensive in South Africa.
- 3)Price of gas has direct impact on my work due to distances traveled and put pressure on my budget .
